1. Harker moved and Telling seconded a motion to approve minutes from 3/27/19 and 6/7/19.

2. Harker moved and Telling seconded a motion to approve the purchase of 20 tick tests. Passed 2-0

3. Phil and Mary Ellen Banks:

b. Concerned about an unknown number of people camping in the woods.

c. Advertising hot dogs along the river.

d. Mooney is concerned that this will turn into the wild west.

e. Identified a YouTube that claims that they sell edibles and buds at the event.

Telling noted that most of these are Planning Board and police issues. P. Banks stated that the previous Sunday the Charlemont police responded to his complaint and went over to the event. Building Commissioner sent the Float and Smoke group a letter telling them that they are violating their special permit and to cease and desist. This was ignored. The Planning Board is taking this up at their next meeting. The BOH will look into the food issue.

4. Received a letter from DEP instructing the owner of 90 Main St. building that he needs to reactivate the public water supply for the new restaurant.

5. Harker moved and Telling seconded a motion to continue membership in MAHB. Passed 2-0

6. Harker moved and Telling seconded a motion that a letter be sent to Roger King giving him until the middle of July to present a septic installer and the installer submitting a time frame for the work. Passed 2-0

7. Harker moved and Telling seconded a motion for Telling and Lingle to remain as co-chairs. Passed 2-0.
