- 1. Crochier reported on his inspection of the Inn. Needs to see in writing what will be done in that area and how it will be secured from non-usable parts of the building. Lingle says he will follow Crochier's recommendation. Crochier reported that the basement is in good shape. Any improvements will need police and fire department signoffs. He also would like plans on how to ensure separation from the rest of the building so people are not bringing stuff into the kitchen area from the other areas.
- 2. Telling reported and Crochier confirmed that the plastic separating the kitchen area from the rest of the building has been breached. He asked if we should lift the condemnation for that portion.
- 3. Lingle moved to maintain the status quo of it being condemned until we get concrete professionally drawn up plans Telling seconded. Telling yes Lingle yes
