4. Air conditioner repairs and maintenance

- a. Pomeroy has been trying to replace the board on the existing air conditioner, but this has been unsuccessful to date.
- b. Pomeroy would like us to purchase a serviceable air conditioner.
 - i. \$7.600 quote for Pomeroy
 - ii. Town to get 3 bids for a replacement unit, and then moving ahead with the replacement.
 - iii. ACTION TAKEN: PURSUE bids to replace the air conditioner in the machine room moved by Ken, second by Mary Ellen
 - 1. Mary Ellen- yes, Lora yes, Cheryl yes, Bob yes, Ken-yes

5. WG&E Rideouts

- a. Bob has approved a rideout from WG&E to access the condition of the network
 - i. Are they looking at trees? It will be interesting to see what is included.

6. Any other business not reasonably foreseen 48 hours in advance of the meeting

- a. National Grid large project related to pole replacements and relocating poles
 - i. Pole attachment contract does not have any protections for the town.
 - ii. The next stage of preliminary design is expected in the first week of June for this project
 - iii. Perhaps National Grid will help us apply for the grant funding?

iv. Low performing power lines are required to be upgraded.

b. Budget numbers approved at town meeting, the numbers were not correct.

i. The town presented last year's budget for town approval by accident.

c. BEAD Challenge

- i. BEAD Challenge process is to identify unserved/ served/ underserved locations.
 - 1. Live on June 10, open for 30 days.
 - 2. Can this be used for installations?
 - a. Would the ISP charge you a non-standard price for installation?
 - b. Can our uninstalled homes be identified as unserved so that these will be eligible for the items for BEAD money?
 - c. Can we generate a BEAD challenge for each? It is one/ unserved home. We have up to 200 eligible homes.
 - d. With BEAD money we could pay for interior wiring of the home can be included in the grant for installation for hot drop.

ii. Can BEAD money be used to expand the network to areas that might be used for approved subdivisions or new homes?

1. Distributed by census block groups.

iii. Can BEAD money be used for network monitoring?

- 1. Follow up with Ted Harvey relating to whether this can be used.
- iv. Bob will follow up related to BEAD challenge or using BEAD money to expand the network.
