9 October 2013

- The minutes from the 11 September 13 meeting were reviewed, signed, and accepted.
- Joe Pellegrino stopped in to inquire about well installation regulations and obtaining a permit. He was advised to be in touch with Charlemont's Health Agent, Glen Ayers, and was given the phone numbers to use for this purpose.
- A request for an installation permit ^{Sept 13} was made by HC Kocot and Sons. A motion to grant the permit was made by Ruth Cannavo, 2nd by Doug Telling. A vote of "yes" was unanimous. *for what?*
- Received notification of health insurance was received by all BOH members. All are adequately insured.

- The Board received a Certificate of Analysis from the Crabapple Water Recreation Company.
- A memo was received concerning a meeting with Representative Mark Kubik. A discussion of current water supply regulations and how these regulations could impede business development and expansion, will be held on 30 September at the Transit facility from 6:00-8:00 pm.
